The American Support Standards Institute (AMSI) quietly began its public presence in autumn 2024.

In early 2025, we launched our first wave of *pro bono* work, focused on developing **voluntary consensus standards** to improve the quality of services for individuals with **intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD)**.
